CROSSROADS OF THE WEST

Cheyenne is a strong community with a volunteer spirit and strong Western heritage. It is a center for business, education and government, but also offers a host of outdoor activities. It is a haven for hunters and fishermen, and boasts extensive hiking and bike trails. In addition, the area presents ample opportunities for golfing, boating and skiing. Founded in 1867, Cheyenne is the capitol of Wyoming, home to large state, federal and local government groups, as well as a substantial private service sector that thrives on the government economy.

The spirit of the old west still runs strong in Cheyenne, as seen in the down-to-earth hospitality of its people. Every year, Cheyenne hosts the Cheyenne Frontier Days celebration, capturing all the tradition of the old west in a grand party that combines the world's largest outdoor rodeo with musical performances ranging from local bluegrass bands to today's top-billing country music performers. Even with all of Cheyenne's old west traditions, the community still manages to balance the new west with the old. Cheyenne offers a varied selection of performing arts such as the Cheyenne Symphony Orchestra, which is regarded as one of the best in the nation for a community Cheyenne's size. By mixing traditional values with forward-thinking vision, Cheyenne offers something for everyone.


ACCESSIBILITY

Cheyenne is situated at the key junction of I-80 and I-25. Travel to Cheyenne by car is quick and easy from most points in Wyoming, as well as from Northern Colorado and Utah. Of the roughly 500,000 people living in Wyoming, approximately 220,000 of them can,

in fact, get to Cheyenne by car more quickly and easily than to Casper. And with our location straight up I-25 from Denver International Airport, visitors arriving from all over the world can get to us within an easy 90-minute drive. Traveling by air is even more convenient, reliable and affordable with the help of Cheyenne's local airport - which offers daily flights to and from many rural and major hubs. In addition, many tourists on cross-country excursions pass through Cheyenne as a natural part of their tour path. The true gateway to Wyoming, Cheyenne welcomes visitors en route to Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, and Devil's Tower National Monument.

The Little America Hotel is located amid beautiful range lands on the edge of Cheyenne. The hotel is nestled just beyond the northwest corner of the junction of I-80 and I-25, and is easily accessed from any direction. It is within five minutes' drive of downtown Cheyenne, the State Capitol, F.E. Warren Air Force Base and Cheyenne Frontier Days Park.
